# VYSA TOURNAMENT RULES

- Except as provided below, FIFA rules and regulations shall have full force and effect.
- FIELDS OF PLAY**-All teams will be scheduled to play on fields secured in the Town of Vestal to include Moore Park (4 fields), Ross Corners (2 fields), Vestal Hills School (1 field).
- CREDENTIALS CHECK**-At registration the following credentials will be checked for:
  - All players must be properly rostered with their team. A certified roster from each team's state associations for the 2006-2007 season. Player pass must be presented for each player, this includes all guest players. **The roster shall have a maximum of 18 eligible players for U-11 and older and 14 eligible players for U-08 through U-10 players.**
  - Each team must have a medical release form for each player participating in case of injury.
  - All teams from outside of NEW YORK STATE WEST district must provide a copy of an approved Permission to Travel Form.
- SUBSTITUTIONS**- Substitutions shall be allowed freely, but only with the proper notification of the referee:
  - Prior to a throw-in in your favor
  - Prior to a goal kick by either team
  - After a goal by either team
  - In the event of a caution or an injury, after the referee has stopped play.
- FORFEITS**- Forfeits will be a 4-0 score awarded to an opponent of a team not appearing at the scheduled game time or a team leaving the field before the game conclusion.
- LENGTH OF GAME**- Each game shall consist of two equal halves as shown below:

**ALL HALF TIMES WILL BE 5 MINUTES DURATION**
- STANDINGS**- The order of finish will be determined by the number of points accumulated. Three (3) points for a win; one (1) point for a tie; zero (0) points for a loss. If two teams have an equal number of points; the order of finish will be decided as follows:
  - Results of head to head competition-in event of a three way tie, this tiebreaker will be omitted.
  - Total goal difference (Max 4 goals per game)
  - Least goals allowed total
  - FIFA penalty kick
- DIVISIONAL PLAY**
  - Four Team Divisions**-Three game round robin and then the 4th game will be (1st vs 2nd) CHAMPIONSHIP game and (3rd vs 4th) CONSOLATION game.
  - Five Team Divisions**- Four-game round robin format
  - Six Team Divisions**-Two brackets will play round robin within the bracket with one crossover game. The 4th game will be 1st Bracket A vs 1st Bracket B CHAMPIONSHIP GAME, 2nd Bracket A vs 2nd Bracket B, 3rd Bracket A vs 3rd Bracket B CONSOLATION GAMES.
  - Seven Team Divisions**-Each team will play a four game round robin within the division with the winners determined by Rule 6 above.
  - Eight Team Divisions**-Two brackets will play round robin within the bracket. The 4th game will be 1st Bracket A vs 1st Bracket B CHAMPIONSHIP GAME. 2nd Bracket A vs 2nd Bracket B, 3rd Bracket A vs 3rd Bracket B, 4th Bracket A vs 4th Bracket B CONSOLATION GAMES.
- UNDER 8 RULES**- U.S. Youth Soccer 4 v 4 Official Rules:
  - Max # of players on field 4 (no goalkeeper, roster size limit 10 players).
  - Goal size 6' x 12"
  - Size 3 ball
  - Game shall be divided into four (4) equal twelve minute quarters. There shall be a two minute breaks between each quarter. Exception half time break of 5 minutes.
  - There will be no off-sides, no penalty kicks, throw-in shall be replaced with a kick-in. Goal kick may be taken within 2 to 3 yards of the goal. Corner kicks opponent must be 6 yards away from the ball.
  - All games will be scheduled round robin and no score will be kept.
- MODIFIED U9, U10 AND U11 RULES**-Rules will conform to FIFA laws with the following exceptions:
  - Max # of players on the field is (7) for U9 and U10 including goalkeeper, and (9) for U-11, including goalkeeper.
  - Substitute 8 yards for 10 yards in FIFA laws for U9/U10 age group.
  - U9 and U10 age groups will be scheduled in round-robin format.
- PLAYOFF GAME FORMAT**-For playoff games only, should the game end in a tie, there will be two (2) five-minute sudden death overtime periods played to determine the winners. There will be no rest between periods. If the game is still tied, penalty kicks shall be taken in accordance with FIFA rules to determine the winner. See Rule 6 for PLAYOFF GAME & OT
- FOULS AND MISCONDUCT**-Any player ejected from a game (issued a red card) cannot be substituted for the remainder of that game, cannot participate in any activities preceding the next game, and cannot participate in the next game. Any coach ejected from the game (issued a red card) cannot be present at the field for the remainder of that game, cannot participate in any activities preceding the next game, and cannot participate in the next game. All red cards will be reported to NYSWYSA. As this tournament has been organized to promote healthy competition between younger players, it is sincerely hoped that all participants, including players, coaches, and fans will join in a positive support for the referees and tournament officials. Coaches are reminded that they are responsible for their players and fans. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to disqualify a team from the tournament for gross misconduct of its coaches,
- PROTESTS**-No protests will be allowed. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to decide on all matters pertaining to the tournament and the tournament rules.
- TOURNAMENT CANCELLATION**-In the event of inclement weather or any other "Act of God" which would prevent continuation of the games, the tournament will be canceled. Partial refund check will be paid to each team at the discretion of the Tournament Committee.
